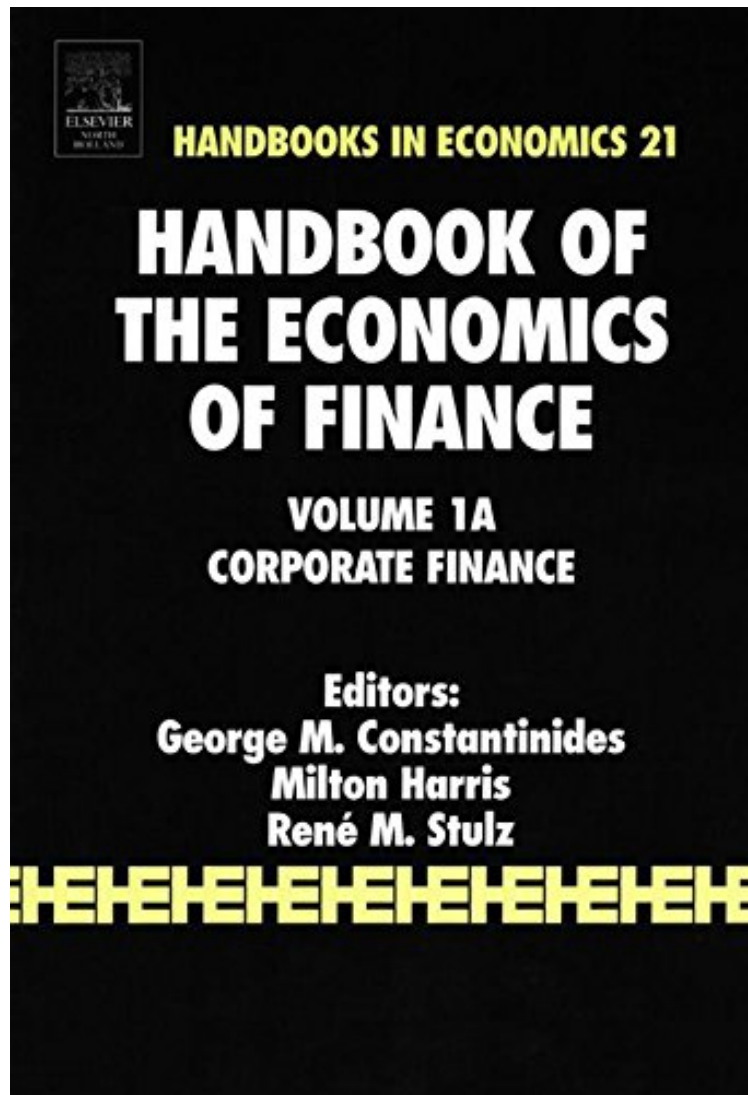

But, ..., a big BUT, it is an overpriced book. Why? only 500 some pages. You may argue the intellectual content is worth a lot. My answer: Yes. You then ask: then why shouldn't we compensate the authors? My answer: hehehe, they are not the original authors. They are EDITORS, who collect the excerpts from other papers. They did us a favor by systematically (and

perhaps subjectively) collating a volume so we don't have to go to the library to collect pieces. Therefore, I think it is a good, useful book, but overpriced...

Volume 1A covers corporate finance: how businesses allocate capital - the capital budgeting decision - and how they obtain capital - the financing decision. Though managers play no independent role in the work of Miller and Modigliani, major contributions in finance since then have shown that managers maximize their own objectives. To understand the firm's decisions, it is therefore necessary to understand the forces that lead managers to maximize the wealth of shareholders.
