In all 3 volumes, there are some illustrations that are only partially there or missing altogether with a descriptive caption underneath an otherwise blank page. The illustrations that are complete are of low resolution. Also, there are the occasional random marks and scribbings here there throughout these 3 books. This can be annoying and

distracting. However, the text information of all 3 volumes is so well written, thorough, and interesting if you enjoy reading this kind of history, that these 3 volumes are still worth keeping.
